ABOUT THIS WINERY

Bodegas Martín Códax was founded in 1986 and is named after the most famous Galician troubadour whose medieval poems, the oldest in the Galicio-Portuguese language, are preserved. A project that started with the dream and the efforts of a group of winegrowers is now a reality and it is this reality that has allowed Bodegas Martín Códax to become a symbol of Galician wines inside or outside of our borders / countries.

TASTING NOTES

Pale pink blush color. High intensity. Fresh red fruit aromas such as cherry, plum and raspberries. Rose and violet floral notes. Structured and full-bodied. Good acidity which heightens the freshness.

PRODUCT NOTES

Cuatro Pasos rises from the Bierzo valley vineyards, where more vigorous and with more vegetation plots protect the clusters from the direct sun influence, providing the Mencía grape with more freshness.

PRODUCTION NOTES

Careful selection of plots in the heart of the valley. Direct pressing of the grapes which allows to obtain a delicate extraction of the color and cold fermentation (18°) to preserve the aromas of grapes and flowers.
