ABOUT THIS WINERY

Caymus Vineyards is 100% family-owned by the Wagners. Charlie, Lorna Belle, and Chuck worked together as a remarkable team for over 30 years building Caymus Cabernet. Today, Chuck, his son Charlie and daughter Jenny, have joined the family team. Farming grapes remain the priority with the family farming about 350 acres of choice Napa Valley land.

TASTING NOTES

Deep purple in color with bright red highlights, this wine has a voluptuous nose of dark plum and cherry, with hints of leather, violets and chocolate. The entry in the mouth is wide and round, with intensely ripe black fruits. A natural acidity born from the cooler air and high altitudes of the Andes weaves fruit and leather into one intertwined character. The tannins are harmonious, grainy and extremely fine, imparting a grainy sweetness to a luxurious fruit finish.

PRODUCTION NOTES

Red Schooner is a red wine of the world, the creation of two great wine cultures. Malbec grapes grown in Mendoza are shipped chilled to California, where they eventually end up in Caymus vineyards and are made into wine. Following the reception of the fruits, the fermentation process begins, followed by aging for 15 months in French oak barrels (50% new).
